Commissioner Wiley,

I am writing to formally request placement on the agenda of the next regular meeting of the Hillsdale County Board of Commissioners so that I may address the Board in an extensive manner, pursuant to Article V, Rule 5.13(4) of the Board's Rules of Procedure and By-Laws. A written agenda-placement request is attached for the record.

The purpose of this request is to present, in public session, a set of documents that now require Board deliberation following sworn testimony, subsequent court action, and a public response issued by a county officer. These materials are submitted to ensure transparency, preserve the record, and allow commissioners the opportunity to determine whether any motion, referral, or other governance action is warranted.

The materials I am requesting to present to the Board include:

- sworn court transcripts from *People v. Scott / Lambert*
- the court's findings and dismissal of the charge associated with that testimony
- the County Clerk's subsequent public written response
- the administrative rule cited by the Clerk, adopted after the conduct at issue
- a briefing memorandum submitted to the Board and County Counsel outlining the governance duties now implicated
- my formal request for agenda placement under Rule 5.13(4)

These materials do not request adjudication, prosecution, or interference with any judicial proceeding. They request only that the Board address, in public session, governance and oversight issues that arise once sworn testimony and public statements by a county officer are placed into the record.

Please confirm receipt of this request and advise whether agenda placement will be provided in accordance with the Board's Rules of Procedure and By-Laws.
